Dr. George Bilotta of *FCS* facilitated the process. He has been traveling to Australia for the past 6 years offering a variety of programs. This is the fourth time that *FCS* has offered its *Human Formation - Formator Formation Process* in Australia.

Work days include formators participating in a one-on-one session with Dr. Bilotta that focuses on their personal process; a 1.5 hour group session; and personal preparation work.

Formators depart the 3-week process prepared to use *FCS's Structured Autobiography* (a 180-page manual) with their persons-in-formation. In addition, various human formation topics and dynamics were covered through group sharing and lively conversation. Through this process and individual follow-up, formators increase their competency and confidence.

FCS plans to offer the process again to formators in Australia either in late September and early October 2011 or in early 2012.
